" SORRY, NO ROYAL WARRANTS!"

A Royal Warrant is an important and treasured honor granted by the British Royal Family to Merchants and others whose products they favor and use.

It may be the Butcher, the Baker, or the Candlestick Maker. Whoever is so honored may add to their letterhead or sign " BY ROYAL WARRANT or ROYAL.WARRANT HOLDER.

Royal Warrants are truly British. Had this ancient and continuing practice a place in Canada a certain holder would be a William Scully Limited, a fourth generation family, occupied in the production of Uniform Regalia and Accourrement.

William Scully hung up his sign on Leader Lane in Toronto in 1877. In 1908 he and two of his three sons set up an all inclusive plant on University St. in Montreal. Advertising and proving that they would equal the products of a number of British Royal Warrant Holders.

The current President, Vince Scully, started working for the firm in 1930. He has had his hands into making Uniform Caps, Cork Helmets, (in their day) Bearskin caps, Busbies, Seal Wedges, Muscrat Yukons, in one department.

In another department, the firm cut steel dies and tools, hubbed, stamped, soldered and plated brass badges and crested buttons, adding vitreous enamel to some.

In yet another department, a full staff spent the daylight hours producing gold and silver hand embroidery for fine gentlemen in Uniform or producing Regimental Stands of Colours. The firm rounded out its line with a world class hand tailor, who was happiest planning a garment on paper, cutting, and sitting cross-legged on a table with needle flying, producing Canadian"Firsts" which included a Lieutenant Governor's Dress Uniform and involved two women in hand gold embroidery work for eight months. Lord Alexander of Tunis, the first Governor General to have his uniforms made in Canada. Others included General MacNaughton and our gargantuan Mayor Camilien Houde who favored modish suits and capes.

From England came stocks of gold and silver bullion, lace, Wilkinson Swords, and special facecloths and plaids.

Customers come from Governments, the Military, Police, Fire, etc. For several generations a family would find the "Scully Label" in their Cub cap right through their uniformed lives to their Legion Berets.

Vince Scully recalls a night visit by Emperor Haille Selassie and having spent the rest of the night cutting and hand sewing a Sam Browne belt down to size. For this, he was given a gold Ethiopian coin and an order for uniform headwear.

William Scully "Firsts in Canada" included Bullet Proof Vests, Finger Print Equipment, Chemical Equipment, Speed Control Traps.

For years, this old and respected firm made and carried a greater range of items for people in Uniform than any firm in England or the U.S.A.

Their most important product is now Uniform Headwear, and followed by badges. The firm still deals heavily and in a modern manner with all of its historic lines currently needed by people in uniform.
